

PNC to Operate Additional ATMs on Penn State Campus; PNC Will Now Operate 15 ATMs in State College

PNC Bank, a member of The PNC Financial Services Group, Inc. (NYSE: PNC), has entered into an agreement with The Pennsylvania State University to operate six additional ATMs on the school's University Park campus and one at Penn State Erie, The Behrend College. The seven ATMs, formerly owned and operated by another financial institution, were transferred to PNC Bank ownership at the end of January.

- Findlay Commons
- Waring Commons
- The Nittany Lion Inn
- The Penn Stater Conference Center Hotel

The six University Park campus PNC Bank ATMs join the nine ATMs the bank operates in State College. In addition, there are four full-service branches in State College: 122 E. College Avenue, 1601 S. Atherton Street, 1408 N. Atherton Street and 2222 E. College Avenue (in-store Nittany Commons Giant supermarket).

The Behrend campus ATM, located in the Reed Student Union, brings to 53 the number of PNC Bank ATMs in the city of Erie.
